the Father everlasting.**

- 3. To you all angels, all the powers of heaven:  
cherubim and seraphim, sing in endless praise**
- 4. Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might:  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.**
- 5. The glorious company of apostles praise you: the noble fellowship of prophets praise you,  
the white-robed army of martyrs praise you.**
- 6. Throughout the world the holy Church acclaims you:  
Father, of majesty unbounded,**
- 7. your true and only Son, worthy of all worship:  
and the Holy Spirit, our advocate and guide.**
- 8. You Christ are the king of glory:  
the eternal Son of the Father.**

- 9. When you became incarnate to set us free:  
you humbly accepted the Virgins womb.**
- 10. You overcame the sting of death:  
and opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers.**
- 11. You are seated at God's right hand in glory:  
we believe that you will come and be our judge**
- 12. Come then Lord and help your people:  
bought with the price of your own blood,**
- 13. and bring us with your saints:  
to glory everlasting.**
